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## NOTIFICATION NO. 827

It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that the Academic Council, at its 52<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 27/03/2017, has considered and adopted the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 ( No. 24-14/2016 (U.G. Regulation). This will be applicable to the students to be admitted in to the BAMS programme from the academic year 2017-18.

In this Regulation, apart from the various other amendments some restrictions have also been stipulated for passing the BAMS examination.

- The duration of the course for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> professionals will be of 12 months and for final, it will be of 18 months.
- The First Professional course should be passed within a period of maximum 3 years by availing maximum of 4 chances.
- Similarly, the Second Professional examination should be passed within a period of further 3 years by availing a maximum of 4 chances.
- Third Professional examination should be passed within a maximum period of 9 years including all chances mentioned above.
- Those who have failed in the 1<sup>st</sup> professional shall be allowed to appear for the 2<sup>nd</sup> professional exam but the student shall not be allowed to appear in the 3<sup>rd</sup> professional exam, unless the student passes all the subjects of 1<sup>st</sup> professional.
- Similarly, the failed students of 2<sup>nd</sup> professional who have passed all the subjects of 1<sup>st</sup> professional examinations shall be allowed to appear for the 3<sup>rd</sup> professional.
- Those who have not passed Second Professional will not be allowed to appear for final professional exam.
- The internship will be of 12 months with daily working hours of not less than 8 hours.
- Rognidan subject is shifted to II<sup>nd</sup> B.A.M.S. curriculum from III<sup>rd</sup> B.A.M.S. and Agadtantra is shifted to III<sup>rd</sup> B.A.M.S. from II<sup>nd</sup> B.A.M.S.

The above Regulation will be implemented from the academic year 2017-18.

The other amendments like change of subjects, the examinations rules such as number of papers, marks of theory and practical, viva-voce, etc., should be followed as per the Regulations from the Batch of 2017-18 onwards.

A copy of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 published in the Gazette of India dated 7<sup>th</sup> November 2016 is enclosed.
