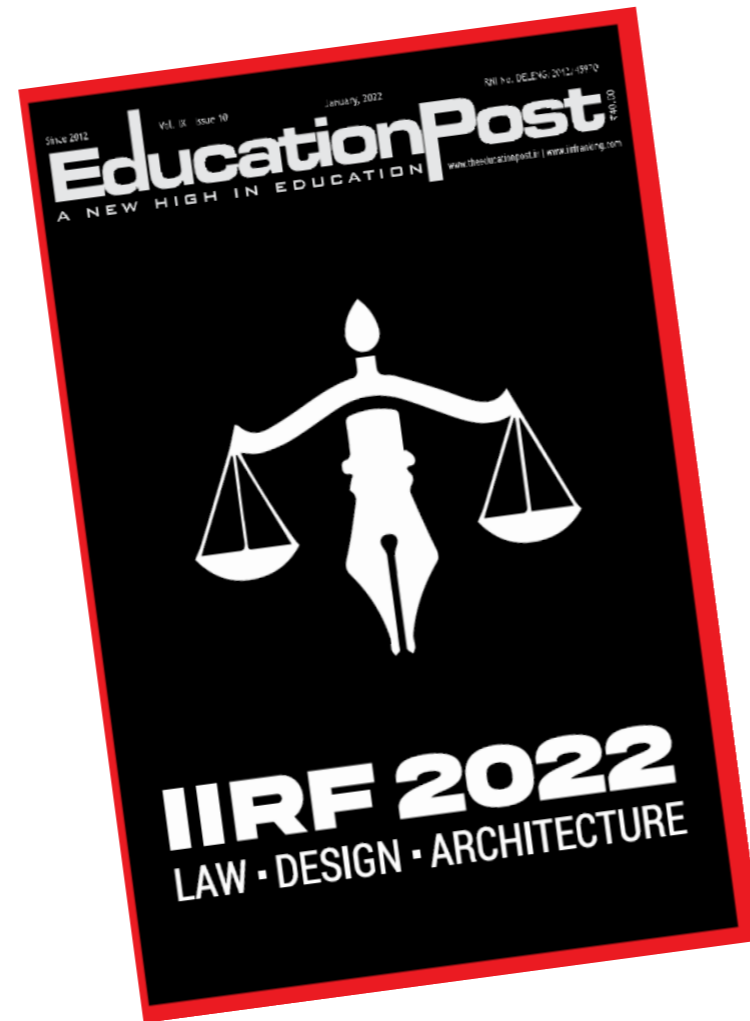

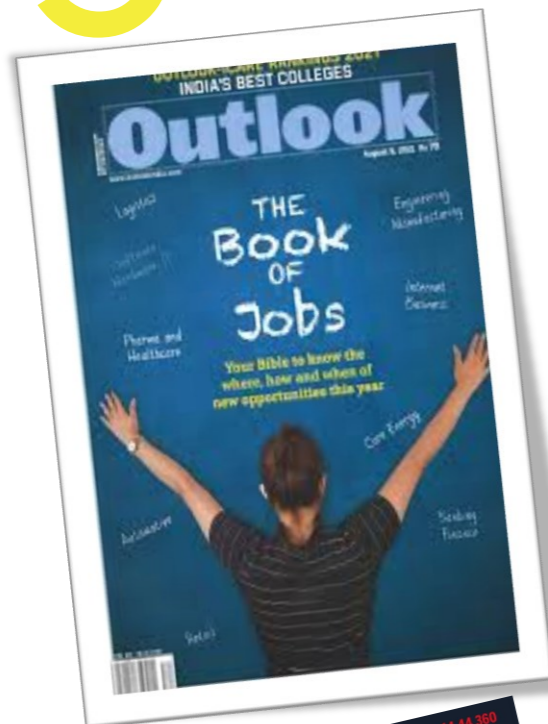

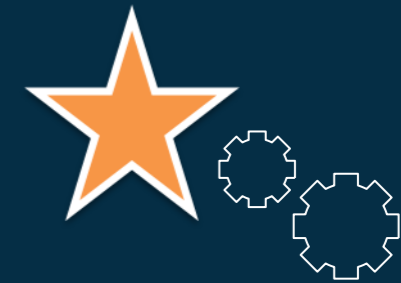

1. In pursuance to the guidelines issued by UGC, Admission to Two Year Post Graduate Programme will be through a Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test.
2. The Candidate who has passed the Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2024 will be admitted to LL.M Two Year Post Graduate Programme at Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) New Law College, Pune in the order of merit secured by him subject to intake capacity.
3. The Candidate shall secure minimum 50% marks in Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2024 to pass the Entrance Examination. The Last date for registrations is **6th July, 2024.**
5. The Group Discussion is scheduled on **15th July, 2024** (From 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.).
6. The result of Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2024 will be on the basis of the performance of the Candidates in the Entrance Test as well as Group Discussion. 70% weight-age will be given to the performance of the Candidates in the Entrance Test & 30% to the performance in the Group Discussion.
7. The result of the Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2024 on the Website of University and College. (Website: www.bvuniversity.edu.in/www.bvpnlcpune.org).
8. The Candidates who have qualified the All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2024, shall attend the counselling for admission (subject to merit and seats available) at Pune and New Delhi for admission to New Law College, Pune.
9. The Candidate shall confirm the admission by paying the total fees prescribed for the Programme on the date of counselling. Subsequent claim for admission will not be entertained after the date of counselling.
10. The admission secured by the Candidate shall remain provisional till the Candidate clears all the eligibility requirements prescribed by the University and the Bar Council of India. In case of non-fulfillment of Eligibility, the Provisional Admission can be cancelled at any stage without giving any notice to the Candidate.
11. Norms for LL.M Two Year will be as prescribed by UGC & BCI from time to time.

The status of University was given to a cluster of these colleges and institutes in appreciation of the high level of their academic excellence and for their potential for further growth.

During the last 25 years or so, the University has achieved higher pinnacle of academic excellence and has established its reputation to such an extent that it attracts students not only from various parts of India but also from abroad. According to a survey conducted by Association of Indian Universities, this University is one among the top ten Universities in the country preferred by the overseas students for admissions. At present, there are more than 602 overseas students from 45 countries on the rolls of constituent units of this University.

During the last 25 years, there has been tremendous academic expansion of the University. It now conducts in all 290 courses in its constituent units, of them 107 are Post Graduate, 40 are Under Graduate and 37 Diploma level and 14 are PG Diploma level courses. 11 Fellowship and 5 certificate courses. All the professional courses which the University conducts such as those of Medicine, Dentistry, Engineering etc., have approval of the respective statutory councils, viz., Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India, All India Council for Technical Education etc.

The University is a throbbing center of research activities and has launched Ph.D. programmes in 79 subjects and M.Phil in 2 subjects. It has also introduced quite few innovative academic programmes such as Masters in Clinical Optometry, M.Tech. in Nano Technology etc.

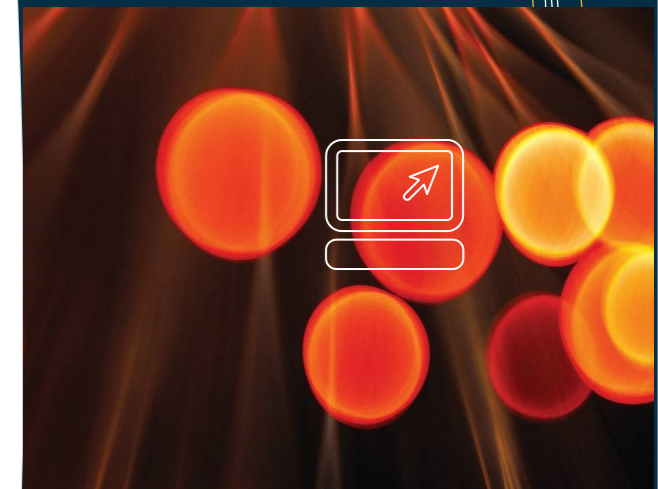

ICT TEACHING METHODS:

Bhagwati 9th International Moot Court Competition on Human Rights wherein 14 international and 30 national teams from top law schools participated. The competition was inaugurated by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dipak Misra, Chief Justice of India through video conferencing in the presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice S.K. Kaul, Judge, Supreme Court of India. The College has also signed MoU with Surana & Surana international Attorneys and conducted a unique National Trial Advocacy Moot Court & Judgment Writing Competition on Criminal Law.

CONTINUOUS LEGAL EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

The College in collaboration with International Bar Association (IBA) & MILAT organizes continuous Legal Education programmes wherein free training is provided to young lawyers, judges, police personnel and teachers for their professional career advancement.

RESEARCH CENTRES:

The College is recognized by UGC under 2f & 12 (B) of the UGC Act for research and development grants. The College has Indo-European Legal Study & International Research Centre and also International IPR Research Centre. This College publishes Bharati Law Journal (ISSN: 2278-6996) which is a UGC approved Law Journal. The faculty has published more than 397 articles in reputed national and international journals and 21 Books. Minor and Major Research Projects are also undertaken.

LEGAL AID:

The College has Legal Aid Cell which is administered by senior advocates from Supreme Court and High Courts. The Legal Aid Clinic of College has resolved 872 cases successfully.

It provides free legal aid to the needy and poor persons who seek social justice. Students are encouraged to participate in Lok-Adalats, Legal Aid Camps, Legal Aid Clinics and community service programmes. The College has established special Family Legal Aid Cell to help women and children.

1 ENTRANCE TEST - GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.1 Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2024 is a ranking examination for admission to LL.M Two Year Programme for 2024-25 academic session.
- 1.2 Applicant may kindly note that mere appearance in the Entrance test and inclusion of name in the merit list does not confer any automatic rights to secure admission to the programme offered by the institute. The selection and admission to the programme is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, any such criteria as may be prescribed by the University and availability of seats to the particular programme and institute at the time of counselling.
- 1.3 Applications of Candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered.
- 1.4 Before initiating registration process, candidates should go through the information brochure carefully for eligibility criteria, and pattern of examination etc. The information brochure shall be available at- www.bvuniversity.edu.in
- 1.5 Incomplete online application, if not in accordance with instructions, will not be considered and processed. Applicant should carefully fill up all the fields during online application process and complete the payment process. Application once submitted finally, cannot be withdrawn/modified.
- 1.6 The Entrance fee, once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances. Candidates who remain absent for the Entrance test will forfeit their Entrance Test Fee.
- 1.7 The Information brochure is subject to modification without notice, please check the website regularly for updations, if any.
- 1.8 The authorities of the institution reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted inadvertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the Entrance Test even though Admit Card/ Registration number has been issued.
- 1.9 The Admissions provided to candidates based on the result of the Entrance Test will be purely provisional and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as mentioned in the information brochure.
- 1.10 Under no Circumstances a change in the examination centre once selected by the Candidate will be allowed.
- 1.11 Candidate MUST bring the following documents to the test Centre- (a) Printed Copy of Admit Card (b) Any one of the authorized photo IDs (Must be original, valid and non-expired) Aadhaar Card/ PAN Card/ Driving License/ Voter ID/ Passport. The Name on the Photo Identification must match with the name as shown on the Admit Card. Candidate reporting to Test Centre without the above said requisite documents shall not be allowed to appear for the Entrance test.
- 1.12 All the Correspondence should preferably be addressed by E-mail. The E-mail query shall be addressed only if it is no anonymous and not vogue.
- 1.13 Candidates are deemed to have read, agreed and accepted the terms and conditions in the information brochure and on completing the registration/ application form for the Entrance Test.
- 1.14 In case of differences of opinion or any ambiguity in interpretation and implementation of any of the instructions/terms/rules/criteria regarding the determination of eligibility/ conduct of examination/ registration of candidates/ information contained herein, the same shall be referred to the Vice Chancellor of the Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) and his decision shall be final and binding on all concerned.

2. Group Discussion (60 Marks)

SYLLABUS FOR ENTRANCE TEST-
There is no defined syllabus for Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test but the Candidates may prepare the curriculum studied by them at LL.B (Three/Five Year Level). The Candidate should prepare mainly the following topics:

- Constitutional Law of India
- Jurisprudence
- Law of Contracts (General Principals)
- Criminal Law
- International Law & Human Rights
- Law of Torts
- Family Law of Marriage & Divorce

ELIGIBILITY-
A Law Graduate from recognized University with minimum 50% mark in aggregate are eligible for admission if they qualify LL.M Entrance Exam. (Candidates who have appeared for the Final Year LL.B Examination may also apply for the Entrance Test.)

ENTRANCE TEST-
1. LL.M Entrance test Paper shall be of 140 Marks.
2. The Question Paper will consist of 140 multiple choice questions.
3. There is no Negative Marking.

GROUP DISCUSSION ROUND-
In addition to the Entrance Test, the Candidates must also appear for the Group Discussion Round which shall carry 60 Marks.

NOTE-
The students who have passed the PG Law Entrance Test by securing 50% aggregate (i.e. 100 marks out of 200 marks) shall be eligible to attend the counselling. The Admission shall be made on the basis of merit subject to intake capacity.

The examination will be conducted on **14th July & 15th July, 2024**. The question paper will be in English only.

MERIT LIST

- Merit list of the candidates who have appeared for LLM (Two year) Entrance Test 2024 for admission in LLM for the academic year 2024-25 will be declared at the website as per schedule.
- Candidates have to login to check their result at www.bvuniversity.edu.in

REFUND OF FEES—

Rules regarding Cancellation of admission and refund of fee will be as per UGC Norms & as per the directives given by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, refer to the Notice Board at the time of Counselling.

- It is advisable that the candidates who have qualified the Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2024 shall visit law college website www.bvpnlcpune.org from time to time for updated information or clarification regarding counselling and admission schedule.

RAGGING

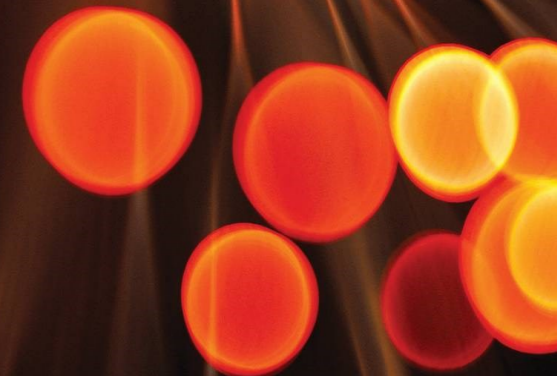
- Ragging in any form is prohibited and is an offence governed by Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 and UGC Regulations 2016.
- Ragging within or outside educational institution is prohibited and is an offence.
- Punishment for ragging is imprisonment up to 2 years & / or fine up to Rs. 10,000/-. Student convicted of offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the college and will not be eligible for admission in any other educational institution for a period of 5 years.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

Limited hostel accommodation is available on the campus both for boys and girls (10 seats for boys & 5 seats for girls). The same will be given on merit basis. The hostel fee once paid is not refundable.

MISCELLANEOUS

- After exhausting the list of students who have qualified the Entrance Test, if any seats are left out, the same will be allotted to the other candidates who had appeared for the Entrance Test in the order of Merit secured by them through subsequent counselling and spot admission.
- The Vice Chancellor shall be the competent authority to lay down the norms for admission in case of vacant seats/ additional section accorded by BCI.

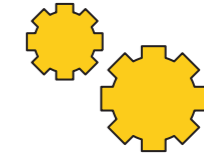

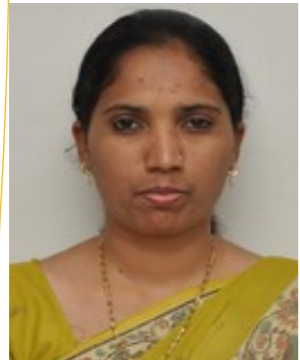

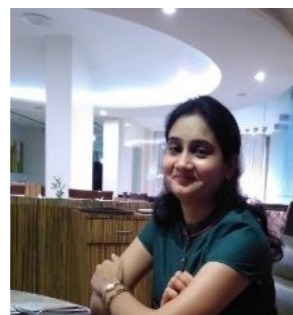
