## 1. Social Activity - Swachh Bharat Mission:

As part of the Swachh Bharat Mission, *Swachhata Hi Seva* activities were implemented from 15th September 2024 to 2nd October 2024, following directives from Dr. V.K. Singh, Director of ICAR-CRIDA. Activities such as awareness programs, cleanliness drives, and debate competitions are planned across all departments of the college through the NSS unit. # 2. Students Training Program:

The traditional approach to education often emphasizes theoretical knowledge over practical skills. However, in today's competitive world, this alone is insufficient for success. Hence, student training is a crucial component of the curriculum. These training programs will help students become self-aware and industry ready. In the meeting, it was discussed that each department should organize at least two training programs per semester. A report on these activities should be submitted to the Principal's office.

#### 3. ONGC Merit Scholarship:

To foster change in Indian society, the ONGC Foundation has been working in areas such as education, health, and livelihoods.
