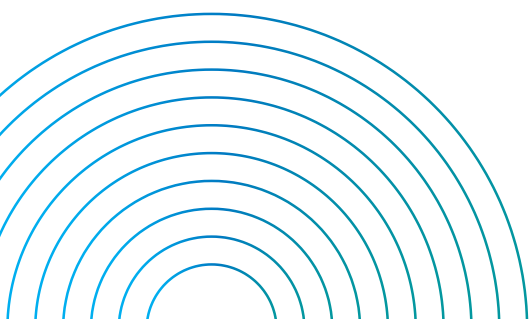
# BV DU BACKGROUND

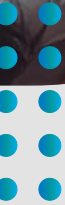
# MISSION

- Summarize written passages and identify main ideas, supporting details, and logical relationships.
- Interpret and comprehend quantitative data, charts, graphs, and tables.

### 3. Applying:

- Apply GMAT strategies, techniques, and formulas to solve quantitative and verbal problems.
- Utilize critical thinking and logical reasoning to analyze and evaluate arguments.
- Implement problem-solving skills to solve complex questions and scenarios.

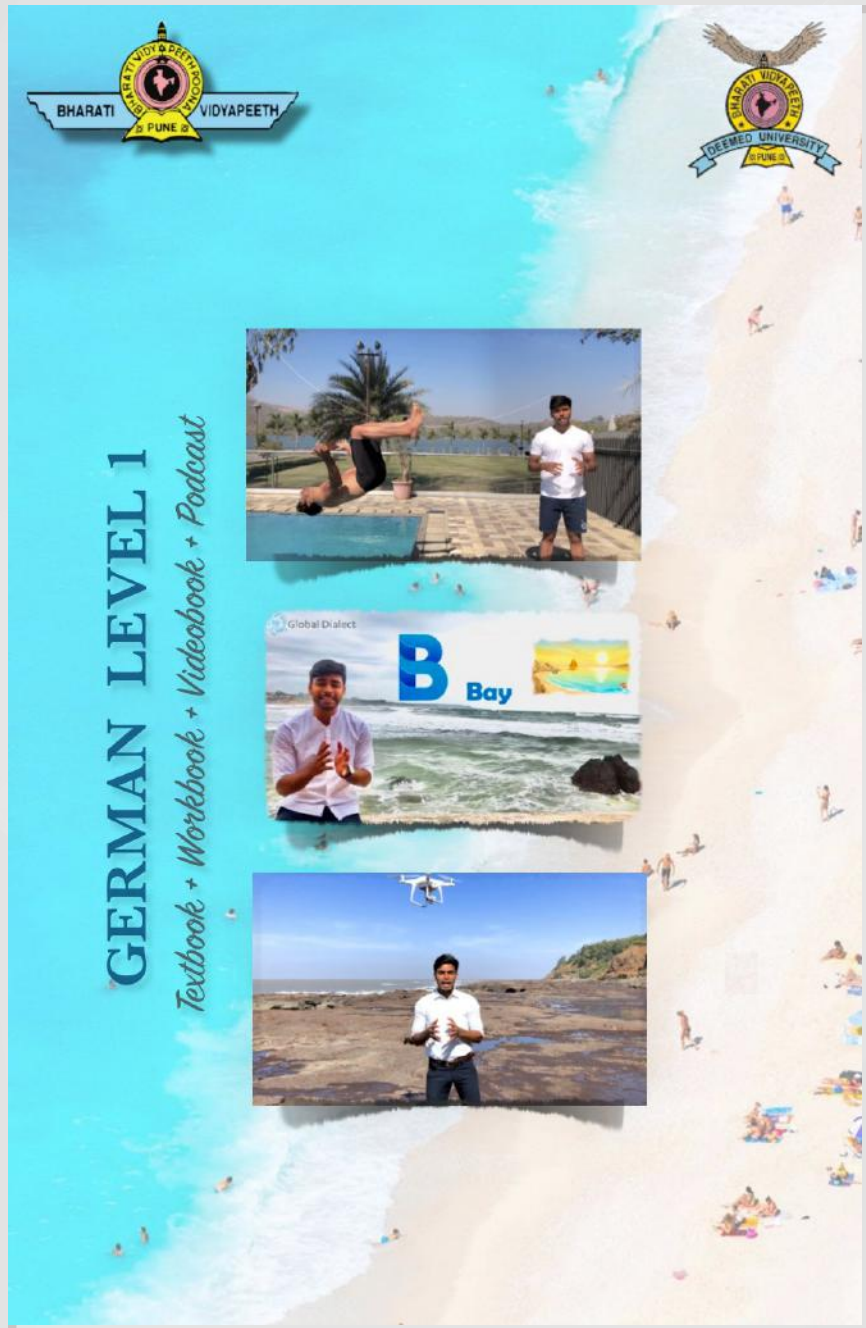
