ENTRANCE **EXAMS**



GRE

The GRE (Graduate Record Examination) is a standardized test that is commonly used by graduate schools in the United States and some other countries as part of the admissions process for master's and doctoral degree programs. The exam is developed and administered by the Educational Testing Service (ETS) and is designed to measure a student's aptitude for graduate-level study.

The GRE exam is divided into three main sections: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, and Analytical Writing.

Overall, the GRE exam is an important part of the graduate school admissions process and can play a significant role in determining a student's eligibility for admission to a graduate program.



GREBLOOM's TAXONOMY

1. Remembering:

- Recall and recognize key vocabulary words commonly found in GRE verbal sections.
- Identify and remember mathematical formulas, rules, and concepts relevant to the GRE quantitative sections.
- Memorize important facts, dates, and events related to GRE analytical writing prompts.

2. Understanding:

- Explain the meaning and significance of vocabulary words in context.
- Interpret and comprehend quantitative data presented in tables, charts, and graphs.
- Demonstrate an understanding of complex written passages and their main ideas.

3. Applying:

- Apply vocabulary knowledge to answer synonym and antonym questions in the verbal section.
- Utilize mathematical principles to solve quantitative problems and apply them to realworld scenarios.
- Apply critical thinking skills to analyze and evaluate arguments in the analytical writing section.

4. Analyzing:

- Analyze and evaluate the structure, organization, and effectiveness of written arguments.
- Break down complex mathematical problems into smaller components for accurate problem-solving.
- Analyze data sets and identify trends, patterns, and relationships in quantitative information.

5. Evaluating:

- Evaluate the validity and soundness of arguments, identifying logical flaws and fallacies.
- Assess and compare the strengths and weaknesses of different approaches to problemsolving.
- Evaluate the quality and effectiveness of written responses based on the given criteria.

6. Creating:

- Generate well-constructed and coherent written responses for analytical writing prompts.
- Create and implement strategies to solve complex quantitative problems efficiently.
- Design study plans and customized approaches to GRE preparation based on individual strengths and weaknesses.

GRE SYLLABUS

1. Verbal Reasoning:

- Vocabulary: Learn and practice high-frequency GRE vocabulary words and strategies for memorization and usage.
- Reading Comprehension: Develop critical reading skills, such as identifying main ideas, making inferences, and understanding author's tone and purpose.
- Text Completion and Sentence Equivalence: Understand and practice strategies for approaching and answering these question types effectively.

2. Quantitative Reasoning:

- Math Fundamentals: Review essential mathematical concepts, including arithmetic, algebra, geometry, and data analysis.
- Problem Solving: Learn problem-solving techniques and strategies to approach quantitative questions with confidence.
- Data Interpretation: Develop skills to analyze and interpret data presented in tables, charts, and graphs.

3. Analytical Writing:

- Issue Task: Understand the requirements of the issue task, practice brainstorming, outlining, and constructing well-supported arguments.
- Argument Task: Analyze and evaluate the structure, reasoning, and evidence in argument prompts, and learn strategies for constructing a coherent critique.

4. Practice Tests and Performance Improvement:

- Full-length Practice Tests: Simulate the actual GRE exam experience through timed, full-length practice tests.
- Test Review: Analyze and review answers to practice tests, identify areas of strength and weakness, and develop targeted improvement plans.
- Test-Taking Strategies: Learn effective strategies for time management, question prioritization, educated guessing, and test anxiety reduction.

5. Test-Taking Skills and Strategies:

- Exam Strategies: Familiarize students with the overall structure and question types of the GRE exam.


