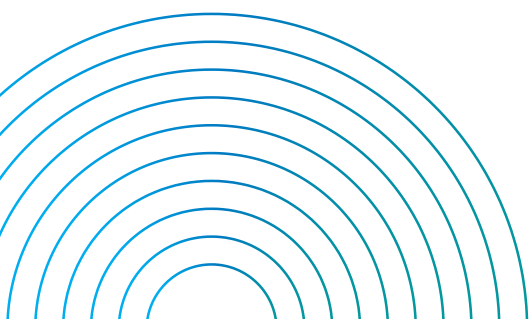
# BV DU BACKGROUND

# ENTRANCE EXAMS



## OET

Healthcare professionals who are looking to work in the healthcare sector in Australia, Canada, Ireland, Maldives, Malta, Namibia, New Zealand, Philippines, Qatar, Singapore, Spain, Ukraine, United Kingdom, United Arab Emirates and the United States of America are required to appear for the OET exam in order to establish their proficiency in the English Language in a healthcare environment.

The content of the test is based on real-life healthcare scenarios, with questions and tasks related to the test taker's specific profession, such as nursing, medicine, dentistry, or pharmacy. Overall, the OET exam is a valuable tool for healthcare professionals seeking to work or study in English-speaking countries, and is recognized as a reliable measure of English language proficiency in the healthcare industry.

## BLOOM'S TAXONOMY

### 1. Remembering:

- Recall medical terminology and vocabulary relevant to the healthcare profession.
- Memorize common abbreviations and symbols used in healthcare settings.
- Recall factual information from OET practice materials and healthcare-related texts.

### 2. Understanding:

- Explain the main ideas and key concepts discussed in healthcare texts.
- Interpret instructions, procedures, and guidelines specific to the OET exam.
- Summarize patient case histories, medical reports, and diagnostic information accurately.

### 3. Applying:

- Apply language skills to understand and respond appropriately to healthcare scenarios.
- Utilize acquired vocabulary and grammatical structures to compose written responses.
- Use effective communication strategies when interacting with patients and healthcare professionals.

## SYLLABUS

### 1. Introduction to the OET Exam:

- Developing effective strategies for managing time, organizing thoughts, and expressing ideas clearly.
- Practicing role-plays and simulated healthcare scenarios to enhance spoken communication skills.

### 6. Medical Vocabulary and Terminology:

- Expanding healthcare-related vocabulary, including medical terms, abbreviations, and acronyms.
- Understanding and correctly using terminology specific to various healthcare professions.
- Practicing the application of medical vocabulary in all sub-tests of the OET exam.

| <b>SECTION</b> | <b>DURATION</b> | <b>QUESTIONS</b>   |
|----------------|-----------------|--|
| Listening      | 45 min          | The Listening subsection is divided into 3 parts that test the candidates listening capabilities in various formats.       |
| Reading        | 60 min          | The Reading subsection is divided into 3 parts that test the candidates reading capabilities in various formats.           |
| Writing        | 45 min          | The Writing subsection is profession-specific and requires candidates to write a letter of reference.                      |
| Speaking       | 20 min          | The Writing subsection is profession-specific and requires candidates to enact a roleplay from the healthcare environment. |
