18th March and 19th March 2024

Two days RCI approved CRE was conducted on 18th & 19th March 2024. Aim of the CRE was to empower rehabilitation professional for early identification and rehabilitation of children with speech, language, hearing, literacy and swallowing difficulties. Specific objectives of the program was to impart knowledge about recent advances in the field and create awareness about the different assessment tools developed in regional languages for children with hearing, speech and language disorders. Newly devised assessment and management tools for children with literacy and swallowing disorders was discussed as a part of this CRE. The CRE educated rehabilitation professionals such as clinical psychologist and Special educators, Audiologist & Speech Language Pathologist (ASLP) and assistant to ASLP regarding the assessment & management options available for children with speech language & swallowing & hearing problems. There was also an exhibition and demonstration of the devices available for rehabilitation of children with speech, language and hearing problems to provide firsthand experience on different parts of cochlear implant, hearing aids and AAC. A copy of the program schedule is attached as Annexure1.

A total 53 professionals participated in the CRE. Out of 53 participants, 51 participants scored more than 70 % in post CRE test results. All the CRE participants rated the overall program as 'very Good' and expressed their desire to participate in more such CRE conducted in future by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) School of Audiology & Speech Language Pathology.


