## REPORT OF MEDICINAL PLANT GARDEN

Medicinal plants are the traditional medicines since thousands of years. Medicinal plants play a vital role in Education and Research. In Ayurveda, the medicinal plants treat a number of health issues and is also used for beauty treatments.

The BVDU, Educational Campus, Sangli has also made the provision for Medicinal plant garden into the campus. The Medicinal plants available in the campus are listed below:


