The session started with an introductory speech by Dr. Mrs. Veena Sakhardande followed by a welcome speech given by Ms. Anjali Kumari. Mr. Krishna Prasad R. – a master corporate trainer, speaker and a communication specialist with 15+ years of experience in training – has conveyed the information regarding a wide variety of scope for nursing around different parts of the world to the students.

He said that, the demand for skilled nurses has increased in many developed countries such as Canada, UK. Australia, USA, New Zealand, Ireland etc. He made the students understand that to work in any of these countries, Indian Nurses who have registered under the Nursing Council have to meet the pre-requisites of language skills along with required academic excellence so that he/she can be eligible for registration.

He also enlisted some countries and discussed the various salary packages provided by those countries for nursing professionals.

INTRODUCTION

From the first day of workshop students came to know about the importance of self analysis in terms of strengths, weakness, opportunities & threats; how to set self goals, importance of effective communication in nursing profession, need for time management, and how the sense of responsibility can produce good nurse leaders.

The second of the workshop was mainly about domain skills in one's life like:

The take away from the second day of workshop was regarding problem solving, how to think critically in emergency situations, importance of making ethically valid decisions. The aspect of customer service was covered by indulging the students in an engaging and interesting activity in which the students came up with innovative & creative ideas . The resource person also taught the students about how to write a resume.

The last day of the workshop dealt with a mock interview for the students. This day the aspects covered are:
