RULES FOR ONLINE POSTER MAKING COMPETITION, 2023

- 1. Once the student registers he consents to all the rules and also declares that he is bound to abide by all the rules which are laid down. Also, he accepts the decision of judges and the organizing committee.
- 2. The participant must be a student perusing graduation (12th plus degree course) in any stream from any recognized college.
- 3. This being an individual competition, no teams of more than one person are allowed. One poster will bear only one Unique Registration Number (URN). Also, one participant is allowed to send only one poster. In case any participant sends more than one poster, only one evaluation will be done at the discretion of the judges, and no complaint for the none valuation of other posters sent by the same participant will be entertained.
- 4. The participants will have to register themselves by completing and submitting a Google form, the link of which is there in the brochure. All the questions in the Google form are to be answered. The participants must upload their photo and college i-card/library card for the current year/semester. (In case the student has gone to the second year/semester, but has not got his i-card or library card, he can use the same as the previous semester. This is applicable only to the students of the second year/semester and above.)
- 5. Any incomplete form or form which is not received by the organizing committee will not be allowed to participate, without any communication.
- 6. Before submitting the registration form, please ensure that all your credentials are correct. Once registration is done, no alteration will be entertained. Please note that incomplete registration forms will not be considered, and your participation can be cancelled.
- 7. The last date to register is 11:59 PM, June 20, 2023. After which no registrations will be accepted, for any reasons whatsoever. Posters must be submitted on the date of competition i.e., June 25th, 2023 from 7.00 am to11.59 pm only, any submissions before or after the said date or time will not be considered.
- 8. There is no registration fee for this competition.

- 9. Participants who have successfully registered will receive a Unique Registration Number (URN) by email.
- 10. Participants shall use only their URN for further communication with the organizers and nothing else.
- 11. Participants are free to use any colours like water colours, sketch pens etc. There is no restriction on the participants for the use of colours.
- 12. Participants shall not disclose their name, email-id, contact, picture, .and class in any form before or during the competition to any other participating student, student representatives, leaders, judges or anyone. Similarly no identity apart from URN should be mentioned on your sheet.
- 13. Violation of any of the rules may lead to disqualification of that candidate, as per the discretion of organising committee.
- 14. Poster should be made on plain white sheet of paper. Participants shall not use any other colour sheet.
- 15. Your poster should contain the following:
 - Name of the competition at top centre.
 - Date and Day of competition at centre under the name of competition.
 - Your URN at right side under the date and day.
- 16. Your poster must not contain any other credentials which reveals or deemed to reveal your identity, failing which will lead to disqualification.
- 17. You must submit your poster by email which will sent to you by organisers.
- 18. The decision of the judges will be final and no grievance of any nature will be entertained.
- 19. All queries relating to the competition may be directly asked to the Organising Committee of New Law College, Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be) University, Pune. Contacts numbers are mentioned below.
- 20. The rules shall be strictly adhered to the organisers reserve the right to disqualify any candidate for deviating the rules.
