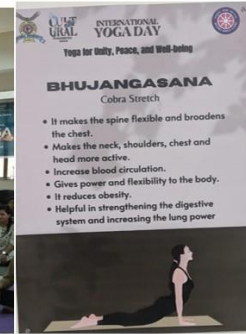

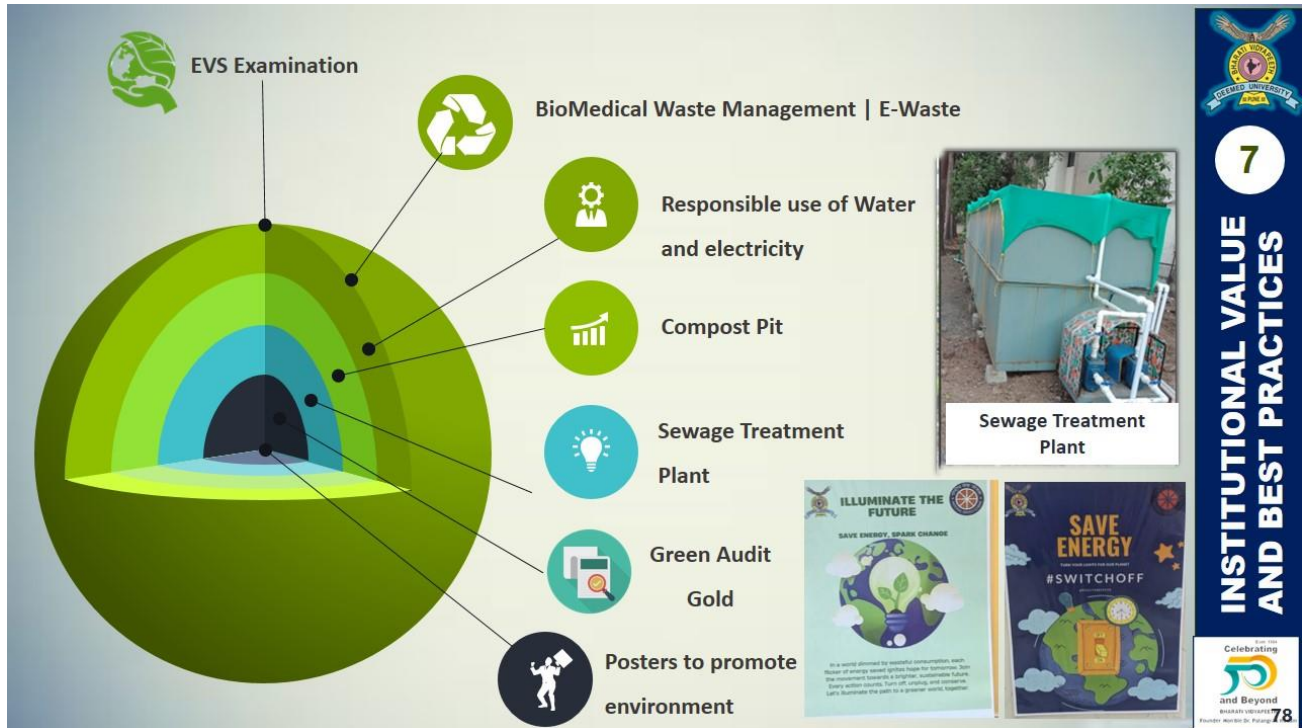
WATER SAMPLE FOR MICROBIOLOGICAL TESTING
