REPORT ON LECTURE SERIES CONDUCTED BY THE LIBRARY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

A series of lectures was organised by the Library Advisory Committee on 21/02/2022 on the following topics:

- 1. An introduction to Shodhganga, Shodhsindhu and Shodhgangotri by Dr. Anupa Shetty
- 2. Predatory journals- wolf in sheep's clothing- by Dr. Anupa Shetty
- 3. Publication ethics- by Dr. V. Sreenivasan

The program was held in lecture hall 01 at 10.00 am.

Around 60 staff attended the event. Dr. Nilesh Joshi, coordinator of the Libraray Advisory Committee, compered the program.



Dr. Anupa Shetty gave a brief introduction and description to the various programs of the INFLIBNET, a part of the UGC digital drive, which can be accessed by the researchers.

While Shodhganga is a platform to access the subscribed journals accessed by the University or college, Shodhganga is a digital repository of PhD AND Thesis and Shodhgangotri is a digita reoisitory of abstracts submitted before the completion of Thesis.

Dr. Anupa Shetty discussed predatory journals in detail.

The Principal, Dr. V. Sreenivasan described the various aspects of Publication ethics in detail.
