

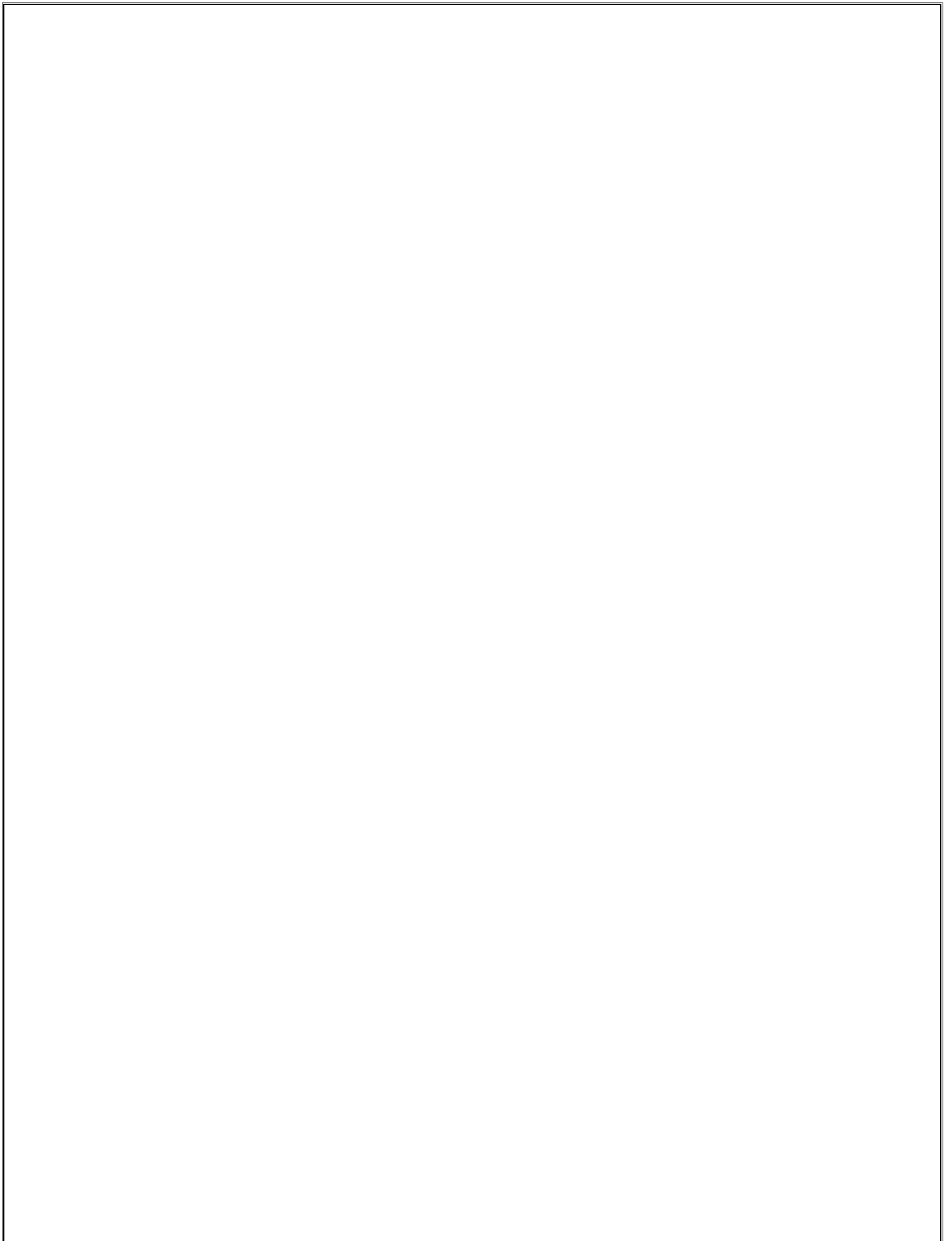

Policy Statement: -

To provide facilities for the students and the staff members with disabilities Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University has undertaken an initiative to formulate a policy document to provide the facilities under the UGC Scheme for Persons with Disabilities. Constitution of the committee under the chairmanship of Vice Chancellor is constituted for the proper monitoring of the activities carried out for the person with disabilities.

Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 prohibits discrimination against individuals with physical and mental disabilities. As per the right of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 Chapter III of Duty of educational institutions. —The University and all the constituent Institutes under Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University shall endeavor that they should provide inclusive education to the children with disabilities and towards that end shall follow the following guidelines as per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

Guidelines for the Constituent Institutions affiliated to Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University.

1. Admit the disability students without discrimination and provide education and opportunities for sports and recreation activities equally with others. The Constituent units under the BVDU will ensure the representation of all the types of disabilities listed in Rights of Persons with Disabilities 2016 and as per government regulations from time to time.
2. Make building, campus and various facilities accessible; such as Ramps, Toilets and Lifts.
3. To provide accessible textbooks and study material to all students with disabilities.
4. Provide reasonable accommodation according to the individual's requirements.
5. Provide necessary support individualized or otherwise in environments that maximize academic and social development consistent with the goal of full inclusion;
6. Ensure that the education to persons who are blind or deaf or both is imparted in the most appropriate languages and modes and means of communication;
7. Detect specific learning disabilities in children at the earliest and take suitable pedagogical and other measures to overcome them;
8. Monitor participation, progress in terms of attainment levels and completion of education in respect of every student with disability;
9. Provide transportation facilities to the children with disabilities and also the attendant of the children with disabilities having high support needs.
10. Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University and all the constituent Institutions will meet the specific needs of students with disabilities regarding the conduct of exams. The examination section has issued the guidelines and regulations for use of scribe in the examination. It will be ensured that all the affiliated colleges follow these regulations.
11. The constituent institutes under the University should carry out the various programmes for the students and the staff members with disability and keep the record of the same.
