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SLOW LEARNERS AND ADVANCED LEARNERS

In their daily interactions and through examination performances, teachers come across students who are exceptional or bright and some who are not so bright. These may be classified as Advanced Learners and Slow Learners. Such a classification helps the teachers to develop and utilize the potential of these learners throughout their time spent at the institute / university.

How we identify these Slow learners and Advanced learners at our university?

First Year - After the first semester Internal Examination,

- The top 20 percent are classified as ADVANCED LEARNERS
- The bottom 20 percent are classified as SLOW learners.

At the beginning of the term, for specific subjects like Mathematics/English, a screening test may be conducted for all students to identify slow and advanced learners accordingly.

Second and other years – Based on the results of the final semester of earlier year,

Advanced Learners - the top 10 percent (or scoring > 80%)

Slow Learners - Those students with backlogs and low attendance

Responsibility of Subject Teachers and Class Coordinator

- Conduct screening test / Based on internal test, prepare classification report of slow and advanced learners
- Prepare schedule for extra sessions /problem solving sessions / revision sessions for slow learners.
- Conduct the sessions for slow learners as per prepared schedule
- Maintain attendance and record of the activities conducted
- Compare performance with earlier performance and update results
- Take feedback of the Slow and Advanced learners on the actions taken
