The counselling and on the spot provisional admission will be for the B.Tech. programme offered in Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), College of Engineering, Pune and Department of Engineering and Technology (Off Campus Center), Navi Mumbai.

3) You will be required to pay the entire amount of fees at the time of admission through online mode at www.bharatividyaapeethfees.com or by demand draft (DD) drawn on any nationalized bank payable at pune in favour of "Principal, BV(DU) College of Engineering, Pune". If you fail to pay the full amount of fees at the time of counselling, you will forfeit your claim on the seat offered to you and same will be allotted to the next candidate in the list and no complaint in this regard will be entertained.

In addition to tuition fee, refundable caution money deposit (Rs.2000/-), Smart card fee (Rs.450/-), Dress code fee (Rs.1000/-), University eligibility form fee (Rs.15/-), University eligibility fee (Rs.200/-), Stationary fee (Rs.800/-) (Total amount Rs.4,465/-) has to be paid through online mode at www.bharatividyaapeethfees.com or by demand draft (DD) drawn on any nationalized bank payable at pune in favour of "Principal, BV(DU) College of Engineering, Pune". Please note that except caution money deposit, the other fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

4) **Hostel fees:** If you desire to have hostel accommodation, limited hostel accommodation is available on the campus both for boys and girls. The same will be allotted on first come first served basis. The hostel room rent and other charges will have to be paid at the time of admission only. There are different hostels for girls and boys each having different fee at Pune campus and Navi campus. The details are given below:

6) As you are aware of the total intake for various programmes, It may happen in the cases of some candidates that admissions to some or all of these courses would be over before their turn comes up. It will, then not be possible to

consider them for admission to any of these courses of their choice. In such a situation, we do not owe any responsibility.

7) The academic session of the first year students will commence from 16th August, 2022. All the students who are given provisional admissions to the respective programmes have to remain present from that day.
